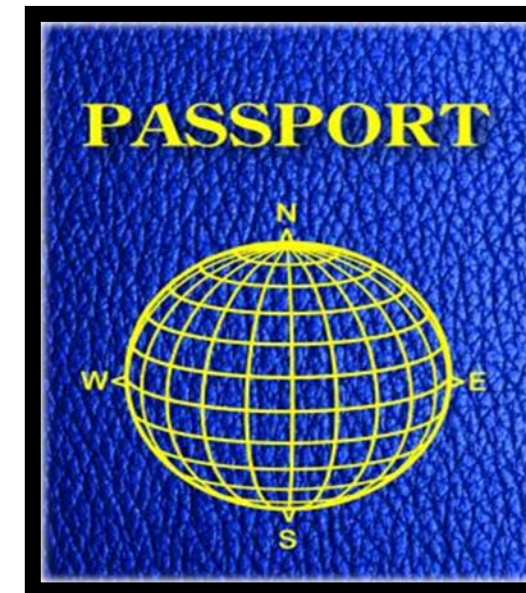


FYE Passport Program



Passport to POSSIBILITIES and SUCCESS

What is the FYE Passport Program? *The First-Year Experience (FYE) Passport Program is open to all first-time, degree seeking students NEW to MC in their first TWO semesters.*

*The FYE Passport Program navigates first year students to campus resources. Students engage in activities and connect with students, faculty and staff as they travel around campus and participate in activities that are described in the passport, getting their passport signed. Once students complete a minimum of one activity in each of the categories, **students will be entered into a drawing to win a prize.***

Students may submit completed Passports through the end of students' first year (Fall or Spring term) of enrollment at the College. Passports should be submitted to Angela Dawson, FYE College-wide Coordinator (16D Campus Center, Rockville [RV]), or Shelly Bennett (TP/SS), Tyra Peanort (GT).

Students must be currently registered to be entered in the drawing. Drawing MAY 18, 2018.

Categories

CM = Career and Major Exploration: assist with exploring different college majors and academic fields as well as defining career goals.

G/C = Global/Cultural: expand your knowledge of other cultures, languages, artistic expression. Attend events that are performances, poetry readings, art exhibits, events sponsored by a department specializing in women's studies, language studies, a specific cultural/ethnic studies department, festivities and events with a cultural theme to get to know a culture that is not your own.

A = Academic Events: expand learning outside the classroom by participating in co-curricular activities and sharpen academic skills through broadening understanding of academic resources available on campus. Attend a lecture, tutoring, writing lab, department-sponsored events.

SC = Social and Community Events: engage in campus community activities that allow you to meet new people, attend club meeting, volunteer or help others and have fun along the way.

F = Financial Literacy: learn about financial aid and how to manage finances to get the most out of the money you have.
