12-week course for family members and concerned friends of people with mental illness. The course balances basic psycho-educational and skill training with self-care and emotional support.

#### **Visions for Tomorrow**

8-week course providing support, education, and training for parents and caregivers of children and adolescents with mental illness.

#### **In Our Own Voice: Living With Mental Illness**

A recovery-education program given by trained consumer presenters for consumers, family members, friends, professionals and lay audiences. Stresses how to cope with the reality of mental illness while recovering and reclaiming productive lives.

#### **Peer-to-Peer**

A recovery education course for pro-active people with mental illness. Nine-week course focuses on wellness and relapse prevention.

A Residential Treatment Center (RTC) offers 24- hour inpatient care in a facility licensed under Maryland Law (COMAR 10.07.04). An RTC provides children and adolescents who have long-term serious emotional disturbance with residential care in a structured therapeutic milieu and provides a range of diagnostic and therapeutic mental health services. RTC treatment focuses on maximizing a consumer's development of appropriate living skills. RTC is a very intense level of care and can only be provided when therapeutic services available in the community are insufficient to address the consumer's need. Discharge planning must be considered prior to placement in an RTC, and plans must be actively reviewed throughout the treatment process.

The County funded and operated services provide assistance to those who do not have access to mental health services; for example, those adults who are “undocumented.” The County, in partnership with the private sector, is committed to reducing the stigma of mental health and increasing the culturally competent services.
