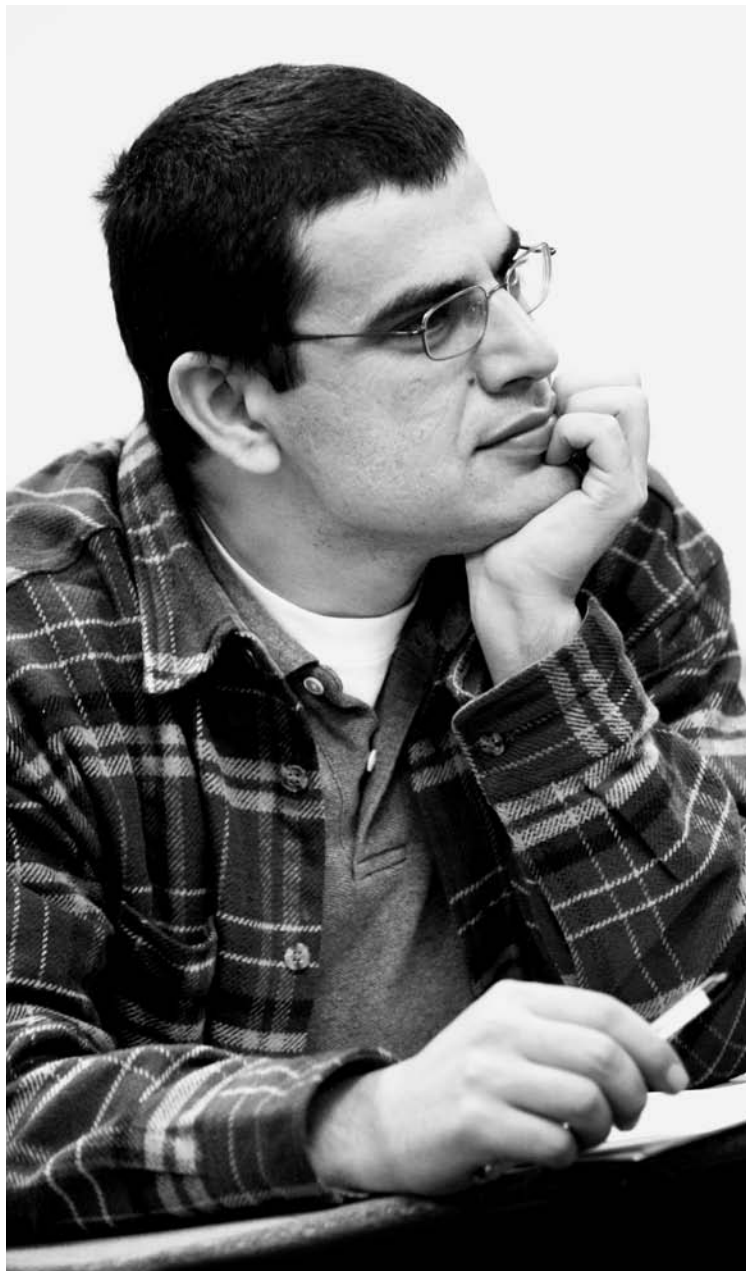


# Tuition, Fees, and, Payment Information



## Tuition and Fees

## Payment

## Student Accountability

Each student is individually responsible for all of his or her tuition and fees. Non-attendance or stopping payment does not relieve the student of his or her financial responsibility for incurred tuition and fee charges. To ensure that the student's financial record reflects the correct charges, the student is responsible for dropping courses through MyMC or at the Office of Admissions and Records before the refund deadline provided in MyMC.

**Outstanding financial balances must be paid before future registration is permitted, grades are released, or certifications, diplomas, or transcripts are issued.** If your account has a cashier's hold due to a prior balance and you pay by Web, the hold will be released in approximately one hour.

## Financial Aid Recipients

Financial aid recipients may deduct expected aid from their tuition and fee charges. If any amount is due, please pay by the scheduled payment due date. Visit the College's financial aid Web pages to review your expected aid, and review your total charges at the Check My Balance link inside MyMC. This should help you calculate any balance you may owe to Montgomery College. If for any reason you do not receive the expected financial aid, you are responsible for all charges on your student account.
