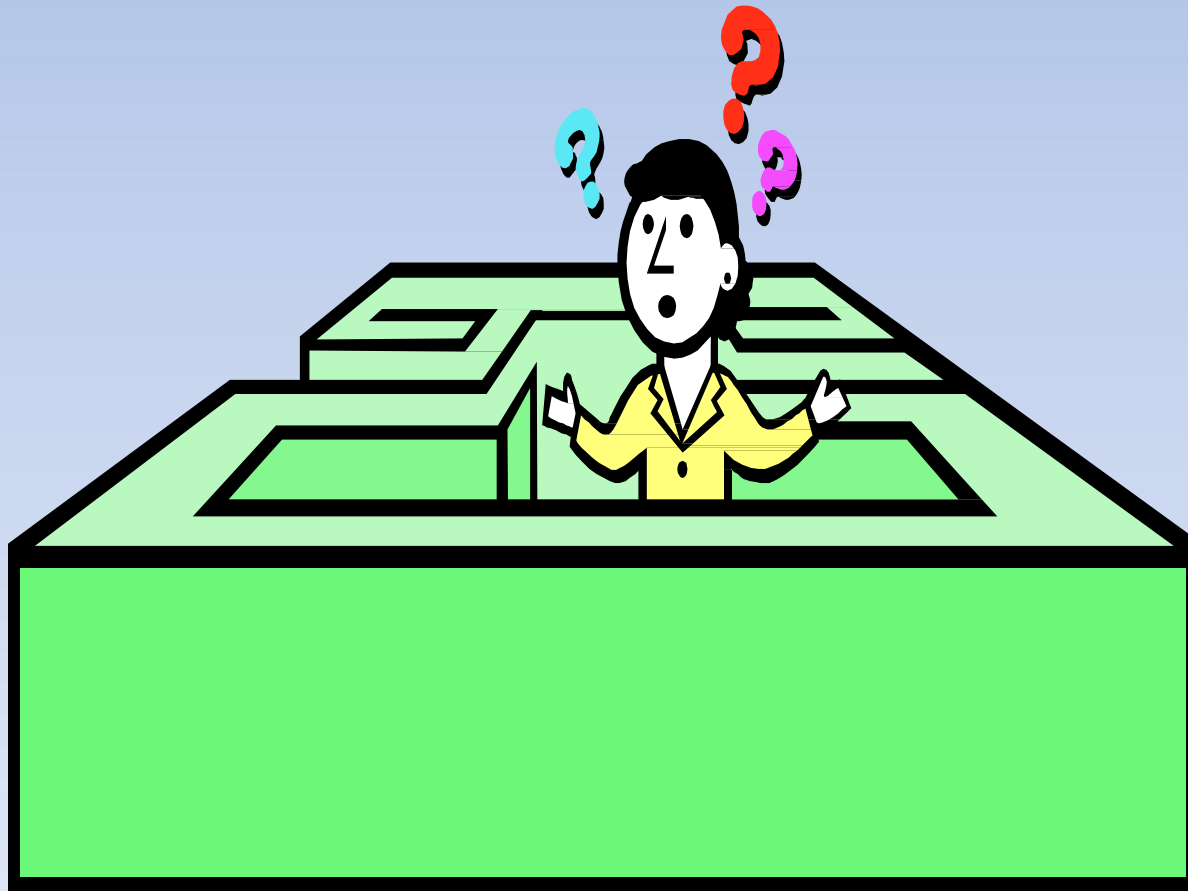
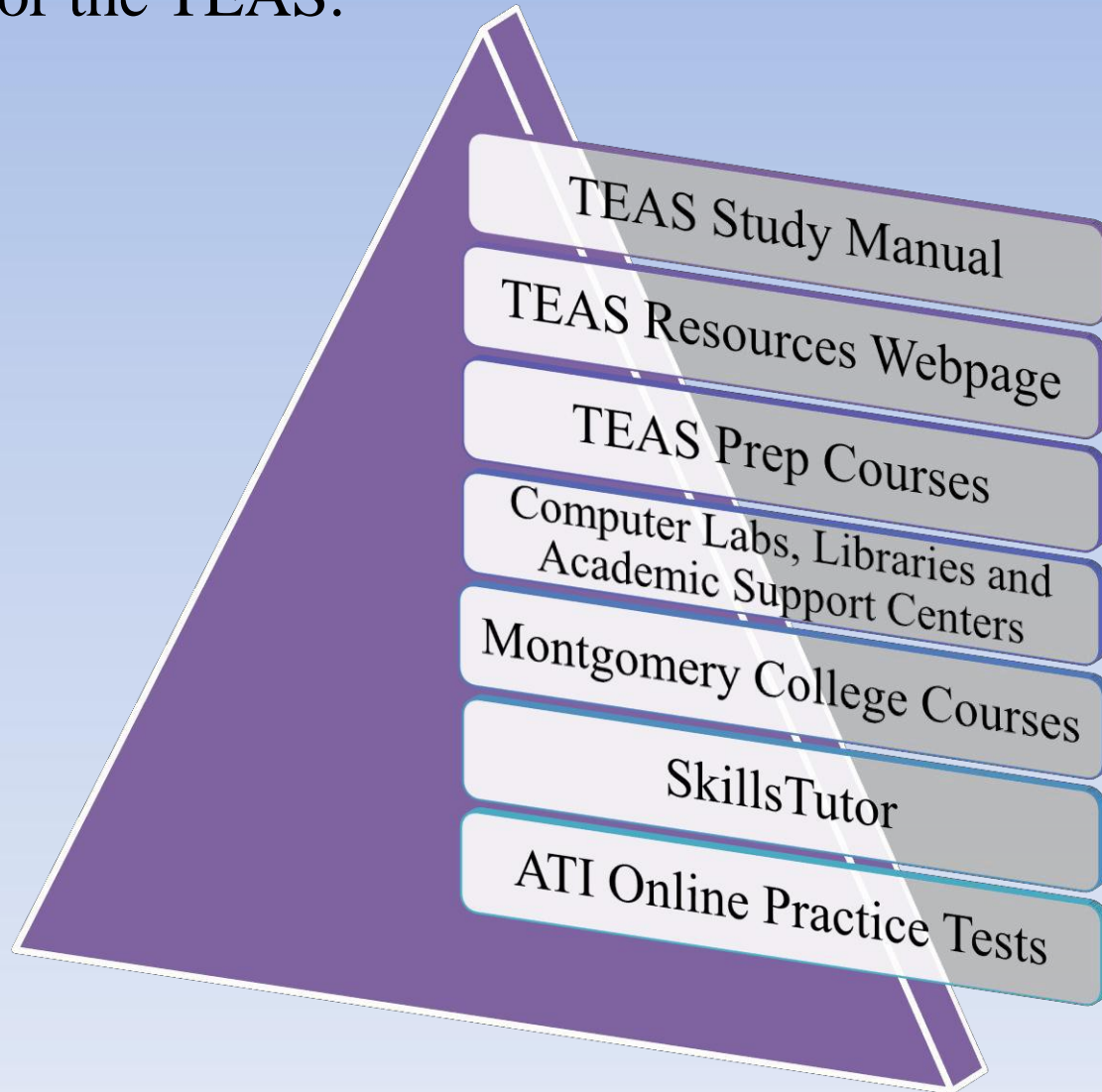

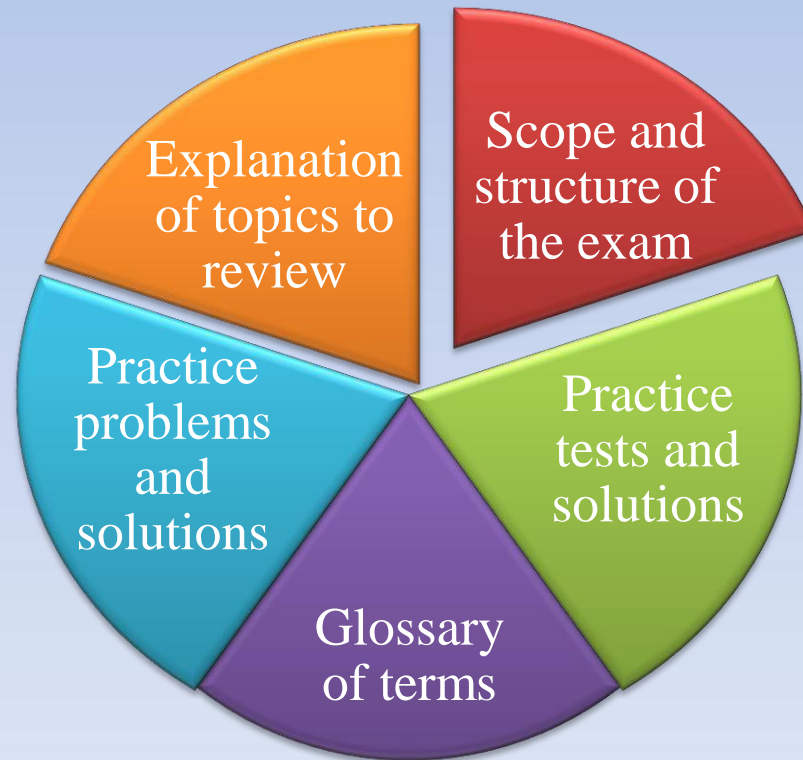
There are many resources available to help test-takers prepare for the TEAS.

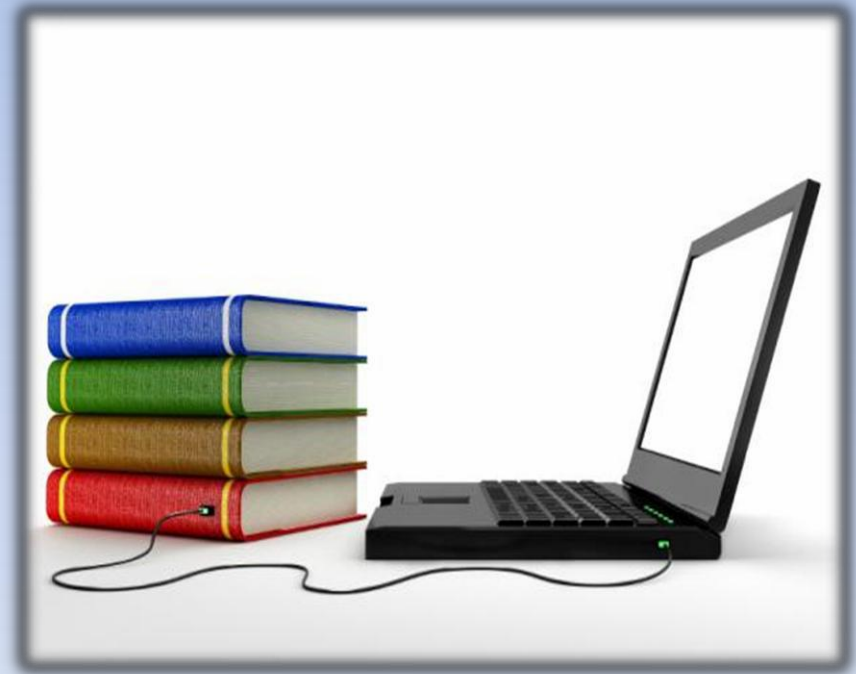

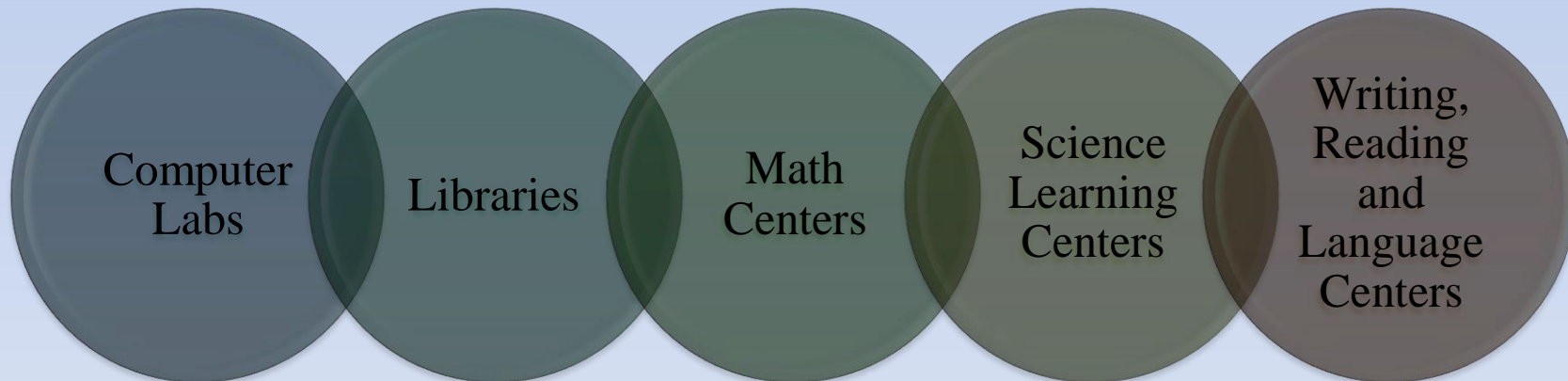
