Alternative Breaks are week and weekend-long service trips that help students learn about social issues through direct service, issue education, and reflection. Students apply to participate in the trips, meet prior to the trip for education and training, and share what they learn after returning through group presentations and re-orientation projects.

cover the majority of their expenses for the trip, which includes low-cost transportation, accommodations (often bunks in temporary housing), and inexpensive group meals, in addition to site materials and staffing. Student Life and the Adopt-a-Breaker Program cover much of the remaining cost and staffing needs—but the program also receives the support of its donors, who help remove the financial barrier that would prevent many of our students from participating. Through the Adopt-a-Breaker program, we are able to provide scholarships to students in need, as well as reduce the overall cost to participate for all.



Alternative Breaks at MC:

The Alternative Break program started on the Germantown campus in 2008 as a Habitat for Humanity trip to the Gulf Region to support communities affected by Hurricane Katrina. Soon after, the program opened applications to all students enrolled at the College. Over 100 MC students have participated in the program serving and learning about issues in Criminal Justice, Community Development, Animal and Environmental Welfare, Child Abuse, and Housing and Poverty. In the future, students will have the opportunity to help develop new projects by serving on the college-wide Alternative Breaks committee and helping support their fellow students as trip leaders.
