

How To Register For Classes at Montgomery College

1. Investigate Financial Assistance

Contact an MC Financial Aid Office for information, application and procedures or go to www.montgomerycollege.edu/finaid.

Apply for Admission

Complete an admission application and submit your application with a \$25 application fee to the Office of Admissions and Records.

2. Complete Assessment and Placement Testing

Take the **ESL Accuplacer Test** in SA110. Bring your MC-issued ID number and photo ID.

The writing sample is 25 minutes. The other four parts are untimed.

Testing in Germantown is Monday-Thursday: 9am-5pm, Friday: 9am-2pm. Call 240-567-7739 for the test schedule.

3. Attend an Advising Session

To obtain your assessment test results, you are required to attend an IMAP (orientation session).

If your English placement permits you can take the math placement test. Referral needed.

4. Meet with a Counselor

Meet with a Counselor in the Center for International and Multicultural Students (SA150). Check the website for walk-in hours:
www.montgomerycollege.edu/International.

5. Log on to MyMC

MyMC is where you can register for classes, view deadlines, access your MC email account, get a parking decal, print your schedule, check your payment status, view your grades, and check campus activities.



6. Register for Classes

Register early via MyMC or in person with a written approval from a counselor.

7. Pay Your Tuition

Pay the bill at the cashier's office or via MyMC using Visa or MasterCard. Pay your tuition by the deadline date.

The cashier will give you a sticker (proof of paid registration) to get your student ID.

8. Obtain Your Student ID

Take your proof of paid registration to SA186 and sit for a photograph. You will receive your ID card immediately.

With your student ID card, you can check out library books and use the computer/writing labs, swimming pools, and ride Ride On buses in Montgomery County 24 hours a day for free (while you are a Montgomery College student). Student IDs are validated each semester with the current semester's registration sticker.

9. Get a Parking Decal

To register your car you will need to log on to MyMC and register to get a parking permit at no cost.



10. Buy Your Books
