

Criteria for Exemption from Placement Testing

- **Earned a degree from an accredited U.S. college or university.** *Students who have been out of college for at least three years and who intend to take a math or English course are advised to take the Accuplacer.*
- **Completed a college-level (not developmental) English and/or mathematics course with a C or better at an accredited U.S. college or university.**
- **Personal interest students taking their first eleven credits, other than English or math.**
- **Additional course assessment waivers may be granted (and in some cases, credit awarded) on the basis of scores on specific CLEP, Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate, and SAT II exams.** [Contact the office of Admissions and Records for more information.](#)
