## TRANSFER OF COURSES BETWEEN MONTGOMERY COLLEGE AND THE ART INSTITUTE OF WASHINGTON

- 1. Students transferring to AiW with the Associate's degree from MC will be guaranteed admission to the institute in one of the commercial art programs.
- 2. Students will have completed their General Education courses except for the additional Art History courses required for NASAD accreditation.
- 3. AiW will evaluate credits that students have earned through Advance Placement (AP) and College-level Examination Program (CLEP). AiW will also evaluate courses and credits earned at other accredited institutions of higher education.
- 4. Students may transfer up to 96 quarter credit hours into The Art Institute of Washington that can be applied towards their Bachelor's degree. Each course at AiW is a four-credit course, except for Life Skills (LS095) which is a one-credit course.
- 5. Transfer students will be required to take program-specific 100- and 200-level courses after transfer to AiW. If students know they want to transfer to AiW, they can be admitted for early decision and co-enroll to take their 100- and 200-level program-specific courses as they complete their Associate's degrees at MC.
