

GRADUATION RATE SURVEY -- STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, and the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, Montgomery College is reporting the graduation and transfer rates of students who entered the College in Fall 2009 as first-time, full-time, degree- or certificate-seeking students. These graduation and transfer rates are computed based on the student's status three years after entry (i.e., Fall 2009).

The data reflect that of the 2,304 students who entered as first-time, full-time, degree- or certificate-seeking students in Fall 2009, 17.0% had graduated and 23.0% had transferred to another postsecondary institution within three years, making the Montgomery College combined Graduation / Transfer rate 40.0%

FALL - TO - FALL RETENTION RATES -- STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, and the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, Montgomery College is reporting the fall-to-fall retention (return) rates for new full-time and new part-time students. These data represent the percentage of students who entered in Fall 2009, or 2010, or 2011 who returned the following fall semester (i.e., Fall 2010, 2011, or 2012). The return rate for full-time students for the most recent Fall-to-Fall timeframe was 74%, and for students beginning on a part-time basis was 52%.
