Students may demonstrate foreign language proficiency through other methods, see: <a href="www.umbc.edu/mll/gfrs.html">www.umbc.edu/mll/gfrs.html</a>. If exempt, take a general elective in place of language courses.

† Physical Education Requirement - UMBC students must take two different PE activity courses. UMBC does not count PHED credits toward graduation; therefore, 2 additional credits of electives are needed to reach 60 transfer credits from MC. Students may fulfill both the MC AA requirement and the UMBC PE requirements with HLTH100 and 2 PHED courses OR 1 PHED and HLTH125 or HLTH150 (3 credits each). HLTH125 and HLTH150 include a physical activity component, therefore 1.5 credits fulfill 1 PHED req. & 1.5 credits will transfer as elective credits. Exempt: at least 30 years old, or with documented military service or a medical condition.
