Students may demonstrate foreign language proficiency through other methods, see: [www.umbc.edu/ml/gfrs.html](http://www.umbc.edu/ml/gfrs.html). If exempt, take a general elective in place of language courses.

† **Physical Education Requirement** - UMBC students must take two PHED activity courses. UMBC does not count PHED credits toward graduation; therefore, 2 additional credits of electives are needed to reach 60 transfer credits from MC. Students may fulfill both the MC AA requirement and the UMBC PHED requirements with HLTH100 and 2 PHED courses **OR** 1 PHED and HLTH125 or HLTH150 (3 credits each). HLTH125 & HLTH150 include a physical component, therefore 1.5 credits fulfill 1 PHED req. & 1.5 credits will transfer as elective credits. Exempt: students at least 30 years old, or those with military service or a medical condition.
